RECYCLING COMPUTERS AND TELEVISIONS

The NJ Electronic Waste Management Act takes effect January 1, 2011. New Jersey is joining more than 20 other states in banning the disposal of computers and televisions, and requiring manufacturers to develop a "takeback" system where residents, small businesses and institutions may drop off various electronic components at no cost. This new law offers Monmouth County and its municipalities the opportunity to greatly expand its existing recycling efforts at little or no cost.

Presently, the County has four recycling sites. Currently, these sites are not accepting large televisions and wooden consoles. The County will be accepting proposals early next month, which will allow the handling of all types of televisions.
