A RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH THE RATE OF INTEREST TO BE CHARGED ON DELIQUENT TAXES AND THE EXTENSION OF THE GRACE PERIOD FOR ONLY THE THIRD TAX QUARTER OF 2017

**WHEREAS**, The State of New Jersey was late in adopting a state budget and the County may not supply a tax rate to the Borough of Allenhurst until mid-July or later which may delay the mailing of the 2017 tax bills until late July or early August; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, an interest free period authorized pursuant to RS 54:4-67, (PL 1994 Chapter 72) or the twenty-fifth calendar day after the date that the tax bills for the third installment are mailed. If payment for the third installment 2017 tax quarter is received after the twenty-fifth calendar day beyond the mailing date of the final 2017 tax bills, interest at the rate of eight (8%) percent per annum will be charged on the first \$1,500.00 of the delinquency and eighteen (18%) percent per annum on any amount in excess of \$1,500.00 from August 1, 2017 to the date of payment and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, That this resolution is to be effective for the third installment of 2017 tax quarter and does not affect past or future tax quarters and shall apply only if tax bills are mailed out late.

## **ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION**

There was a request for a bake sale at the beach club from Brian Reynolds for his service project to raise money for the Beauty Foundation for Cancer Care. The Commissioners approved.

There was a request for a table at the Beach Club for constituents. The Commissioners denied.

Special events permits for selling at the beach club were discussed. Dani Risi has requested to set up a table to sell merchandise. Commissioner McLoughlin stated he does not want it to become a bazaar. Also, all businesses in town should have a chance. Going forward the Borough will approve on a two week basis and open up to all businesses. The policy will be reviewed next year for the 2018 season.

Ms. Gnassi asked for a parking permit to allow one spot in front of her house at Allen Avenue. The Commissioners approved.

Mrs. Varley asked to have her mother's caregiver's daughter to join the beach club. The Commissioners denied.

## **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Maryann Dowling asked if the beach club staff could park at the train station and take the beach club bus, to free up parking spaces. The Mayor stated, unfortunately, the Borough does not have the mechanism to enforce it.

There was a brief presentation by Ben Hanbicki, pool consultant, on what the Borough could do with reconstructing the pool drains.

There being no further business or comments, Commissioner Bolan moved, seconded by Commissioner McLoughlin that the meeting move to executive session at 8:50 PM. Motion carried.
