- The Correspondence from the EMS Captain regarding expediting the resolution of the Contract to place a Repeater Tower at the Asbury Towers was discussed. The Borough Attorney advised that the Borough has no way to expedite. The Asbury Towers has had the contract in their hands since the 1<sup>st</sup> of May. The Borough Attorney has reached out on multiple occasions, but has received no response. Commissioner McLoughlin advised that the Fire Chief would need to follow-up and get back to the Borough Attorney with the name of someone who will talk to him.
- Commissioner McLoughlin spoke about Fire/EMS memberships at the Allenhurst Beach Club. Comm. McLoughlin tasked Richie Heitmueller to reach out to the Fire/EMS membership for criteria of who is entitled to a free beach membership as the Borough would like to memorialize it. The Borough would like a list of all those that meet the decided upon criteria each year from the Fire/EMS.
- The Mayor requested that the Borough Attorney put in the RFP contract that inspections must be done in the Spring or Summer, when residents are here.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Dina Glynn requested permission to place a POD on the street in front of her home due to emergency renovations. The Commissioners advised Ms. Glynn that there is a Borough Ordinance against placing a POD on any street. The Borough is unable to make an exception to the law. The Commissioners offered Ms. Glyn some alternative solutions – put the POD in her driveway, call the owners of the old JCP&L property and ask if she can place the POD in their lot temporarily, call neighbors and ask it she can use their driveways, or to ask the insurance company to cover the packing expenses.

There were no other public comments.

There being no further business or comments, Commissioner McLoughlin moved, seconded by Comm. Bolan that the meeting move to executive session at 8:05 PM. Motion carried. After reconvening, Commissioner McLoughlin moved, seconded by Comm. Bolan that the meeting be adjourned at 9:30 PM. Motion carried.
